TITLE: Including Board Report F in Evidence-based Academy Educational Programs

WHEREAS, every non-third-world nation other than the United States has a system of universal health care; and

WHEREAS, all of these health systems rely to varying degrees on a single-payer system to achieve universal health care; and

WHEREAS, most patients and many physicians don't understand health care systems in general and single payer systems in particular; now, therefore be it,

RESOLVED: That the California Academy of Family Physicians ask the American Academy of Family Physicians (AAFP) to include the data and conclusions of 2017's Board Report F in evidence-based Academy educational programs, continuing professional development/education activities, and stage presentations at AAFP meetings in the areas of health care policy, health care economics and health care systems.

NOTE: Report F was a well-written document; it's uncertain how its content specifically would be incorporated into the venues proposed, however.
